



PRE-ENROL YOUR CHILD

For the 2017-2018 school year

You will need to pre-enrol in SchoolZone, even if your child is continuing at the same school. Ready to get started?



PRE-ENROL BY APRIL 18

Select your child's designated school

Every home address has a designated public school, but it isn't always the one closest to your home. Visit epsb.ca/fast or speak to your child's principal to find your designated elementary, junior high or high school.

OR

Select any other District school

The school must have available space and your child must meet any entrance criteria of that school.

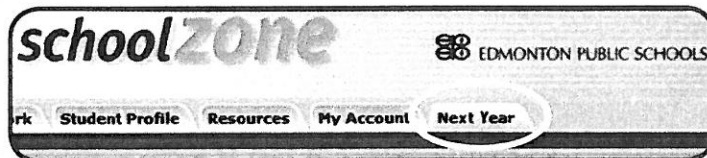


HOW TO PRE-ENROL IN SCHOOLZONE

Between 9 a.m. on March 13 and 4 p.m. on April 18, 2017

When you sign in to your parent SchoolZone account:

- choose the Next Year tab
- select the name of the child you are pre-enrolling
- follow the instructions to select your child's preferred school



Course selection is NOT part of selecting your preferred school in SchoolZone.

Junior high and high school students will choose specific courses (e.g., fine arts, career and technology studies) through a separate process at their current school.

Register your child

Instead of using SchoolZone, students who are new to Edmonton Public Schools or entering Kindergarten will need to submit a completed Student Registration form by April 18, 2017. To get the form and view a list of accepted documents confirming your address and your child's legal name, visit epsb.ca/schools/register.

Need help?

Talk to your child's current school principal if you need help signing in to SchoolZone or completing pre-enrolment.

What happens after you pre-enrol?

You've completed pre-enrolment. What happens next?

You pre-enrolled your child in their designated school.

Congratulations! Your child is enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year.

You selected a school other than your designated school and there was space available for your child.

Congratulations! Your child is enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year.

You selected a school other than your designated school and there wasn't enough space for everyone who applied.

The school will determine successful applicants by **random selection**.

Your child was successful in random selection.

You will be informed of the results of random selection no later than **APRIL 25**.

If your child was chosen by random selection, congratulations! They are enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year.

Your child was not successful in random selection.

The school will inform both you and your child's current school no later than **APRIL 25**. Your child's current school will work with you to discuss options and help you enrol in another school.

Your child can choose to attend their designated school, or any other District school, as long as the school has available space.

What is random selection?

Some schools and programs don't have enough space for all the students who want to attend.

If the number of students who want to attend the school or program exceeds the available space, new applicants from outside the school's designated attendance area are chosen by random selection.

We use the random selection process to ensure all students have an equal opportunity to attend the school or program of their choice.
