



Applying for **YELLOW BUS SERVICE**

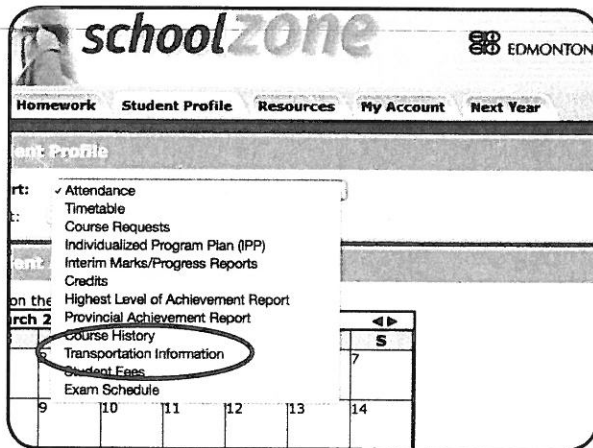
 **You need to apply each school year.**

For **CURRENT** yellow bus riders

1. Apply for continued service to your current school in SchoolZone no later than **May 26, 2017**.

When you sign in to your parent SchoolZone account:

- choose the **Student Profile** tab
- select **Transportation Information** from the drop down menu
- follow the instructions to apply for yellow bus service for next year



2. If you need to **update your address**:
 - select the option to print a paper application form
 - mark any changes and sign the form
 - return it to your child's school no later than **May 26** with documentation to verify your address

Who can't apply for continued service in SchoolZone?

- Students currently in Grades 6 or 9 who will be transitioning to Edmonton Transit System (ETS).
- Students in special education needs programming.

For **NEW** yellow bus riders

1. Contact your child's preferred school for the 2017–2018 school year for information on yellow bus service eligibility.
2. If your child is eligible, complete and submit an application form **no later than May 26, 2017** to ensure your child receives bus service on the first day of school.

Service for elementary students includes:

- yellow bus service for elementary students who attend their designated school and live outside the walk boundary
- some yellow bus service for elementary students who travel to a school to attend an alternative program

Service for junior high and high school students includes:

- Edmonton Transit System (ETS) as the preferred way for junior high and high school students to get to school. For more information, visit takeets.com.
